

# CJ7 Only - Wrangler Adjustment on next page

## Tools Needed

- 1/8" 7/32", 5/32", 3/8" Drill Bits
- Flat Screwdriver
- and Drill Motor
- Phillips Screwdriver
- Center Punch
- Hammer
- 1/8" Allen Wrench
- 7/16" Wrench
- Adjustable Wrench
- 10" Tape Measure
- #20 Torx
- Ratchet
- #40 Torx (may be required for some models)

**Warning:** Improper windshield adjustment will result in poor fitting top and doors, causing looseness or undue strain on the top.

**CJ7 Windshield Adjustment:** If necessary, loosen the two screws in the Windshield Clamps at the base of the windshield on each side of the vehicle. Adjust the windshield forward or back, use a shim if needed to position the windshield, and tighten the screws.

## Windshield Measurement

**Before installing the top,** check the windshield measurement. The distance from the top lip of the windshield to the top outer edge of the body must be 75 1/8" on both sides of the vehicle. Measure from 6" inside the doors.

## Step One

**CJ7:** After adjusting the windshield, install the Windshield Brackets. Place the Windshield Brackets flush with the frame on the upper corners of the windshield. Use the bracket as a template to mark, center punch and drill two 5/32" holes for each bracket. Mount each bracket to the windshield frame using two #10 x 1/2" Pan Head Sheet Metal Screws.
